

LICENSE AND SALE OF PHOTOGRAPHS
Version in force since 16/02/2026
In case of discrepancy, the French version shall prevail.

1. DPPI

DPPI refers to **DPPI PRODUCTION**, a simplified joint-stock company (SAS) with share capital of €45,000, registered with the Paris Trade and Companies Register under number 794 588 194, having its registered office at 6 and **DPPI MEDIA**, a simplified joint-stock company (SAS) with share capital of €40,000, registered under number 533 962 478, with the same registered office.

2. DEFINITIONS

- **Accessories:** Any ancillary item available for purchase in addition to a Photograph (such as framing). Identified on the DPPI Website under the “Prints and Framing” offer.
- **Client:** Any User placing an Order with DPPI on the DPPI Website.
- **General Terms and Conditions:** These general terms applicable to any Order placed on the DPPI Website, having full contractual value between DPPI and the Client. They supplement the Specific Conditions.
- **Specific Conditions:** The conditions resulting from the Order, forming the contractual agreement between DPPI and the Client together with the General Terms and Conditions. They include the subject of the Order (selected Photographs and Accessories, usage rights granted, quantities, Price and Total Price).
- **Order:** Any order placed by a Client for an offer marketed by DPPI on the DPPI Website (license for Digital Photographs or Paper Photographs, Accessories, etc.). Orders are accessible to Users located in mainland France, with delivery limited to the same territory.
- **Photographs:** All photographs referenced and available for order on the DPPI Website, regardless of format (downloadable digital or paper).
- **Digital Photographs:** Downloadable, non-standalone digital files available under the “Digital Visual” offer.
- **Paper Photographs:** Physical photographic prints available under the “Prints and Framing” offer.
- **Price:** The price of a Photograph or Accessory as displayed on the DPPI Website, which may vary depending on format, resolution, materials, etc.
- **Total Price:** The total amount payable by the Client for the Order.
- **DPPI Website:** The websites accessible at <https://dppiheritage.com/> and <https://media.dppi-images.com/>, owned and operated by DPPI.
- **Third Party:** Any individual or legal entity other than the User, Client, or DPPI, including affiliated companies, subcontractors, or distributors of the Client.
- **User:** Any user of the DPPI Website.

- **Permitted Use:** Use of the Photographs strictly in accordance with the rights granted by DPPI and the Specific Conditions, excluding any Prohibited Use.
- **Prohibited Use:** Any use contrary to public order or to the restrictions set out in Article 7 of the General Terms and Conditions.
- **Non-Compliant Use:** Any use that is not a Permitted Use or that falls under Prohibited Use.

3. PURPOSE AND APPLICABILITY

These General Terms and Conditions define the terms governing all Orders placed on the DPPI Website.

Any Order implies prior acceptance of these General Terms and Conditions.

DPPI may amend them at any time; however, the version applicable to an Order is the one in force on the date of that Order.

4. USER ACCOUNT – WEBSITE AVAILABILITY – ORDER PROCESS

4.1 User Account

Placing an Order requires the creation of a User account with accurate and complete information.

The User is responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of login credentials.

DPPI shall not be liable for any Order placed using lost, stolen, or improperly shared credentials.

DPPI reserves the right to suspend a User account in the event of Non-Compliant Use.

4.2 Order Process

The Client must validate the cart through a “double-click” confirmation process.

Final validation constitutes a firm Order, subject to the statutory right of withdrawal.

4.3 Website Availability

DPPI undertakes an obligation of means to ensure Website availability and may temporarily suspend access for maintenance.

5. PRICES – PAYMENT TERMS

Prices are indicated in euros, all taxes included, excluding delivery costs.

Payment is due in full at the time of Order by credit card via DPPI’s secure payment provider.

DPPI does not store or process banking data.

6. DELIVERY OF PHOTOGRAPHS AND ACCESSORIES

6.1 Digital Photographs

Digital Photographs are made available immediately after Order via a downloadable, non-standalone file, subject to waiver of the right of withdrawal.

Usage rights are personal, non-transferable, and non-sublicensable.

6.2 Paper Photographs and Accessories

Delivery is carried out by DPPI-approved carriers within mainland France only.

Risk transfers upon delivery.

Any damage must be reported immediately to the carrier and DPPI.

6.3 Complaints

Any complaint must be submitted to DPPI's customer service.

7. USE OF RIGHTS ATTACHED TO PHOTOGRAPHS

7.1 Prior Information

Usage rights are detailed before purchase and form part of the Specific Conditions.

7.2 License

The Order grants a non-exclusive license strictly limited to the rights specified.

Any Non-Compliant Use engages the Client's liability.

7.3 Prohibited Uses

Prohibited uses include, but are not limited to:

- illegal or defamatory uses,
- commercial or promotional use without express authorization,
- use infringing moral rights,
- use on social media,
- misleading association with brands or individuals,
- incorporation into trademarks or logos.

7.4 Consequences of Non-Compliant Use

DPPI may terminate the license and seek compensation.

8. THIRD-PARTY RIGHTS

DPPI only guarantees the rights it holds. The Client bears responsibility for respecting third-party rights.

9. RIGHT OF WITHDRAWAL

Applicable only to consumers and non-professionals under French consumer law.
Withdrawal period: **14 days**, subject to exceptions for immediate digital downloads.

10. RETENTION OF TITLE

DPPI retains full ownership until full payment is received.

11. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

No intellectual property rights are transferred through the sale of Paper Photographs.
Any reproduction or exploitation beyond granted rights is prohibited.

12. LEGAL WARRANTIES

12.1 Conformity Warranty

In accordance with Articles L217-3 et seq. of the French Consumer Code.

12.2 Hidden Defects Warranty

In accordance with Article 1641 of the French Civil Code.

12.3 Handling Precautions

Improper handling voids any warranty.
